Rationale

The school requires the cooperation of parents in sending children to school clean and tidy wearing the following items of **school uniform** which may be purchased at any large store. St Margaret Clitherow jumpers and cardigans can be bought from L Mob or Tesco's. Ties can be bought there and also through the school office.

	White blouse Grey skirt/pinafore dress Maroon jumper/cardigan with school logo School tie.	Red and white check dress Maroon jumper/cardigan with school logo Sun hat to be worn outside when sunny
	Girls are also allowed to wear trousers. These must be 'school style' and grey in colour. Year 6 girls are allowed to wear their winter skirts with a school polo shirt as an alternative to the check dress.	
Boys	Winter/Spring	Summer
	White shirt (long sleeved) Grey trousers Maroon jumper with school logo School tie. School maroon fleece (available if required)	Maroon polo shirt. Grey trousers or shorts Maroon jumper with school logo Sun hat to be worn outside when sunny
PE	Maroon school fleece Black/Grey tracksuit bottoms Black/Grey shorts White T-shirt Plimsolls or trainers. PE bag (Tights cannot be worn in PE so a spare pair of socks should be kept in the PE bag.)	

- Black shoes must be worn
- Long hair must be tied back with simple accessories, not headscarves/oversized bows.
- Short hair must not have designs shaved into it.

All items of clothing must be marked with child's name.

Jewellery - The only jewellery that can be worn is a watch and stud type earrings. Earrings must be removed by the child for PE/Sports activities as they represent a potential hazard not only to the wearer but also to other children. Medical advice confirms that any jewellery worn in physical education lessons is an unnecessary risk and should be avoided at all times.
